#### NomCom Process

- RIPE community governance (open to all)
- not RIPE NCC corporate governance
- ripe-727, ripe-728
- THE most elaborate and detailed RIPE process
- Follow it on ripe-list and NomCom Blog !
- NomCom closely adheres to the process, it worked so far

## What Happened First

- NCC Board appointed NomCom chair [September 2019]
- Chair called for volunteers [RIPE79]

RIPE

- Chair called for nominations [RIPE79]
- Chair ran volunteer selection process
- Chair requested liaisons (NCC, PC, WG chairs)
- Chair bootstrapped 'previous chair' role

- We had a meeting to organise ourselves
- We called again for nominations and canvassed
- We received four more nominations:
  - Filiz, Niall, Nigel & Mirjam
