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- Proposed Mandate:
  - Review the work done by the Diversity TF
  - Review and incorporate community comments and RIPE NCC impact assessment
  - Publish and seek consensus for three documents:
    1. Code of Conduct
    2. Selection of Trusted Contacts/Code of Conduct Committee
    3. Procedures for trusted Contacts
